- February 21 – “**TRAVEL/WELCOME**” for international participants to Jose Marti International Airport, Havana, Cuba. Afternoon walk in old Havana with stops for local food and beverages. Evening reception at Oratorio San Felipe Neri to include a lecture about W.A. Mozart *String Quartets* and a Cuban music concert by Crisantemi Quartet. Quartet and chamber orchestra rehearsals.
- February 22 – “**CUBAN REVOLUTION**” guided walk and cultural immersion at Capitolio Nacional, Museo Nacional de Bellas Artes and Museo de la Revolucion. Quartet and chamber orchestra rehearsals.
- February 23 – “**LA RUTA DE MOZART**” festival concerts in plaza locations in old Havana. Evening reception at Oratorio San Felipe Neri to celebrate W.A. Mozart, scholarship and international collaboration.
- February 24 – “**ARTISTIC RELEVANCE**” guided walk and discussion to Paseo del Prada, Malecon, Avenue Carlos Manuel de Cespedes and Art Market and Malecon. Evening reception and private Cuban music concert by Café Quartet at Galeria Taller Gorria.
- February 25 – “**TRAVEL/DEPARTURE**” for international participants from Jose Marti International Airport, Havana. Morning meeting to review “La Ruta de Mozart” and set 2018/2019 goals.
